



## Wreaths across America and Washington DC

Each December on National Wreaths Across America Day, our mission to Remember, Honor and Teach is carried out by coordinating ceremonies at Arlington National Cemetery, as well as at more than 1,600 additional locations in all 50 U.S. states.*

### Day 1: Wednesday, Dec. 11, 2019

We arrive in Washington Reagan airport and connect up with the shuttle to our hotel. We have a free afternoon and evening to explore on our own.

### Day 2: Thursday, Dec. 12, 2019

Today we participate in a morning wreath laying ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Arlington Cemetery and stroll through the cemetery recalling those who served and the price of freedom. We have time for lunch on our own, then regroup and

transfer to the Pentagon for a tour of this amazing facility. Afterwards we take an overview tour of the DC/National Mall area including opportunities for a couple of photo stops before we return to our hotel. The remainder of the day is on our own. **B**

### Day 3: Friday, Dec. 13, 2019

This morning we visit the unknown gem Museum on O' street with its fascinating history and a sight to behold. Later subject to availability, we visit the Diplomatic Reception Rooms for a tour where

#### **Deposit**

\$250.00 per person due at time of booking - final payment due 75 days prior (Sept. 27, 2019) to departure. Invoice will be sent prior to final payment.

#### **Cancellation Policy**

All cancellations must be in writing. The date of postmark will determine the amount of refund due. Refunds are based on the number of days prior to departure date. From the time of deposit to 99 days (Sept. 3) before departure, a \$100 administrative fee plus any airfare penalties will be assessed. From 99-14 days, a \$300 cancellation penalty plus lost airfare deposits and any unrecoverable deposit to ground suppliers will be assessed. Airline tickets once purchased are nonrefundable. Anyone canceling less than 14 days prior (Nov. 27) to departure will receive no refund.
