



**Day 1: Saturday, February 19, 2022 • Departure**

Our journey begins as we board our international flight bound for Egypt.

**Day 2: Sunday, February 20, 2022 • Cairo**

Welcome to Egypt, one of the world's greatest ancient civilizations. Upon our arrival in Cairo we transfer to our hotel with the remainder of the day at leisure. Tonight, we attend an orientation meeting and welcome drink with our Tour Manager and fellow travelers at the hotel.

**Day 3: Monday, February 21, 2022 • Cairo, Pyramids of Giza & the Sphinx – the Grand Egyptian Museum**

After breakfast, we visit the Pyramids of Giza, which were built during the 3rd and 4th dynasties of the Old Kingdom. These monumental undertakings stand as a marvelous testimony to the almost unbelievable skill and determination of their builders. We enjoy an up-close view of the Great Pyramid, built for the Pharaoh Khufu, as well as the Pyramids of Khafre and Menkaure. Not far from the Pyramids, we see the great Sphinx of Giza, the legendary statue with the head of a human and the body of a lion, amazingly carved out of one huge piece of limestone. Next, we enjoy lunch at an authentic Egyptian food restaurant. Then, we visit The Grand Egyptian Museum next to the Pyramids, which is the largest cultural project of modern times, displays one of a kind collection of artifacts dating almost 7000 years ago. Your visit includes a special ticket to the Exhibit of the Boy king Tut-Ankh- Amon with pieces displayed for first time since the tomb discovery by Howard Carter exactly one century ago. B/L

**Day 4: Tuesday, February 22, 2022 • Wadi Natrun Coptic Monastery - Alexandria**

After breakfast, we will start a wonderful Over-day experience to Alexandria, the second largest city in Egypt which was the capital of Egypt for a thousand years under the Greeks and the Romans, On the way there, we will have a brief guided visit to St. Makarius Coptic Monastery by one of its Monks, learning about Monastic life and Coptic history and see churches and icons enjoy its Mediterranean atmosphere and highlights, including the New Library of Alexandria, the Roman Amphi-theatre, view the Citadel of Quait-bay, which was built replacing the famous light-house of Pharos, enjoy the views of the Sea while having lunch on the Ancient royal Harbor of Alexandria before, returning to Cairo. B/L

**Day 5: Wednesday, February 23, 2022 • Nile Cruise  
Optional Abu Simbel, Nubian Village, Felucca**

After breakfast we fly to Aswan, an ancient frontier town. Upon our arrival we spend the morning at leisure or join the *optional* Abu Simbel tour (\$370). The flight from Aswan to Abu Simbel transports us back in time to the mighty Temple of Abu Simbel, reclaimed from the floodwaters of the Aswan High Dam and totally reconstructed in the present location. The site is dominated by the looming twin temples of Ramses II and his wife Queen Nefertari. It is one of the most recognizable ancient sites of Egypt. Later we fly back to Aswan and check into the Nile Cruise, our beautiful home for the next three nights. After lunch, we join a cultural visit to the Nubian Village with its spice market and visit a Family House. Sailing through the National Parks of

Aswan, we can watch for local & migrant birds, various plants. We learn about the Nubians' origin, culture, ancient & modern history. Later we end our day with a beautiful Sunset Felucca Ride, the traditional sailboat of Egypt used along the Nile. B/L/D

**Day 6: Thursday, February 24, 2022 • Nile Cruise**

After breakfast, we take a tour to the spectacular Aswan High Dam, an engineering miracle when originally constructed in the 1960s. The dam brought an end to the Nile's devastating floods. We continue to the Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis, and marvel at the temple's beautiful island location. Our tour concludes with a visit to a granite quarry which holds the largest known unfinished ancient obelisk. In the afternoon, we cruise on the legendary Nile River to Edfu. We stop to tour the imposing Greco-Roman Temple of Kom Ombo that is dedicated to Horus, the Sky God and Sobek, the Crocodile God. We admire the fascinating detailed reliefs on the walls before we continue sailing to Edfu. B/L/D

**Day 7: Friday, February 25, 2022 • Nile Cruise**

Early This morning, we visit the stunning Temple of Horus in Edfu, considered one of the best-preserved temples in all Egypt. It was built during the Ptolemaic times and was completed over a 180-year period. The temple is dedicated to the falcon god Horus, the son of Isis and Osiris. The temple's extravagant design and sheer size is an indication of the country's prosperity at the time. This afternoon, the ship sails via Esna to Luxor, known in ancient Egyptian times as the city of Thebes. We visit the magnificent Temple of Karnak, dating back over 3,000 years. We walk along the avenue of the Sphinxes and marvel at the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 massive sandstone columns. Afterward, we head to the Luxor Temple to admire the colossal statues of the great pharaoh Ramses II. B/L/D

**Day 8: Saturday, February 26, 2022 • Cairo – Valley of Kings, Hatshepsut Temple – Colossi of Memnon**

This morning, we view the magnificence of the West Bank of Luxor on a tour that includes the Valley of the Kings, the Temple of Hatshepsut and the Colossi of Memnon. We begin with a visit to the UNESCO listed Valley of the Kings, the necropolis of Thebes, and admire the tombs of ancient Egypt's rulers. Next, we head to the Temple of Hatshepsut, a colonnaded structure surrounded by cliffs, and learn about the life of Queen Hatshepsut, Egypt's first female ruler. The tour concludes at the Colossi of Memnon, two massive stone statues of the Pharaoh Amenhotep III. We return to the ship for lunch. In the afternoon, we take a sightseeing tour of the East Bank of Luxor. We transfer to Luxor airport to fly to Cairo and check into your hotel for the night.

The evening is at leisure to enjoy the facilities of the hotel and to dine on own or explore the adjacent City Stars Mall, one of the biggest malls of Cairo. B/L

**Day 9: Sunday, February 27, 2022 • Dubai**

After breakfast, we depart from Cairo airport and fly to Dubai for the rest of our tour. Upon arriving in Dubai, we are transferred to our hotel for dinner. B/D

**Day 10: Monday, February 28, 2022 • Dubai**

Although vast swathes of Dubai are now transformed with contemporary architecture into a modern and luxurious city, traces of the historic town that existed 40 years ago can still be found in some parts. The 'Traditional Dubai City Tour' takes us on a cultural journey through time into with a visit to the heritage area of Bastakiya and 225-year old Fort Al Fahidi which houses the Dubai Museum. A ride on the traditional Abra boat across scenic Dubai Creek. A visit to the Spice and Gold Souks, with tantalizing scents and shimmering jewelry. A drive to Burj Al Arab, the iconic hotel that has established unmatched standards of luxury. We stop to take a photo next to the Jumeirah Mosque, an architectural landmark. A trip to the United Arab Emirates would be incomplete without a thrilling safari in a 4x4 vehicle that takes us to some of the most amazing sand dunes of this region. The unique activity is adventurous yet provides a cultural experience, the Desert Safari with BBQ Dinner ensure a memorable evening amidst a scenic desert landscape. There is dune bashing on some of the highest sand dunes in the region, in a 4x4 airconditioned vehicle. The breath-taking views of the sun setting over the charming desert providing a magical experience. There is a chance to enjoy activities such as sandboarding and camel rides at the authentic Bedouin campsite which also has a henna designer, local attire for trial and refreshments. A delicious barbecue dinner under the stars while being entertained by an enchanting belly dancer and a mesmerizing Tannoura dance performance that leaves us in awe. **B/D**

**Day 11: Tuesday, March 1, 2022 • Dubai**

We spend the day at the capital of the United Arab Emirates and discover how this majestic Emirati city artfully blends the ancient past with the modern present. The 'Abu Dhabi City Tour' is an all-encompassing introductory excursion of the distinctly Arabian sibling of the glitzy city of Dubai. From one of the world's largest mosques, to the mesmerizing and trendy Corniche, there is a lot to take in within this fascinating historic emirate. We visit the beautiful Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque, an architectural wonder and one of the biggest mosques in the world. Stop at the Corniche, the impressive eight-kilometer stretch of perfectly manicured waterfront with children's play area, beach, cafés and restaurants. Next, we visit the Heritage Village, specifically designed to continually remind the younger Emiratis of their rich and colorful past. We visit the Louvre Museum Abu Dhabi.
