

## Southern Comfort in Charleston & Savannah

*Thursday, October 28, 2021—Friday, November 5, 2021*

**Day 1: Thursday, October 28, 2021 • Erlanger, KY**

**Day 3: Saturday, October 30, 2021 • Charleston, SC**

Today, we arrive in Charleston, South Carolina. Established in 1670, this was one of the first settlements in the New World. It played a major role in the history of the country, from early revolutionary times, through the first shots of the Civil War, to a strong naval base in World War II. Upon our arrival in Charleston, we enjoy a **Gray Line Mini-Bus Tour** of Charleston's most historic areas with a local Charleston guide. After our tour, we check into our hotel and have a little time to relax prior to our Harbor **Dinner Cruise**. **Mill House Hotel (B,D)**

**Place** for a guided tour. It is a carefully preserved 18th century rice plantation with America's oldest landscaped gardens, the House Museum and Plantation Stable yards. After our tour, we have a delicious **lunch** at the Middleton Palace Restaurant. Next, we visit historic **Drayton Hall** - an 18th century estate, with insight into early American history. We arrive back into Charleston for dinner. **(B,D)**

**Day 5: Monday, November 1, 2021 • Savannah, GA**

This morning we have **free time** in Charleston before we transfer to Savannah, Georgia. Upon our arrival in Savannah, we take a **tour with a local** guide to visit unique neighborhoods and districts that this city is famous for. On the tour, we wander around the charming southern city veiled in Spanish moss, and see period architecture and beautiful art, murals and gardens,

trendy boutiques and antiques, and perhaps hear a ghost story or two. Tonight, we have dinner at a local restaurant. **Hampton Inn Savannah (B,D)**

**Day 6: Tuesday, November 2, 2021 • Savannah, GA**

After a delicious breakfast, we visit the **Owens-Tomas House & Slave Quarters**. We tour the ancient home and learn about the many families who have occupied this space and see many rooms including the Slave Quarters. After our tour, we have free time to explore more of the enchanting soul of Savannah. Dinner is on our own this evening. **(B)**

**Day 7: Wednesday, November 3, 2021 • Asheville, NC**

Today, we sit back and enjoy our journey towards home. We stop for the night in Asheville and tour the **Biltmore Estate and Gardens**, built by George and Edith Vanderbilt. The estate encompasses 8000 acres of

gardens and manicured grounds, as well as an exquisite Conservatory where orchids bloom amid a vast array of exotic tropical plants. Your self-guided house visit exhibits breathtaking displays of opulence and wealth. We'll see vintage clothing, accessories, furniture and view original art by Renoir and others.
