

Incredible Copper Canyon of Mexico

The largest canyon in North America, the Copper Canyon provides a destination unlike any other. For those who love the unusual and seek adventure, the Copper Canyon is the answer. At an altitude of 8000 feet, the mountain peaks are snow-capped in the winter while the canyon bottom remains a tropical climate. The Copper Canyon is home to the least accultured Native Americans in North America, the Tarahumara Indians, who are semi-nomadic cliff dwellers. The "Train Ride in the Sky" provides the only access to this wilderness and is probably the most dramatic railway journey in the Western Hemisphere as it travels through 86 tunnels and over 37 trestles

DAY 1: Fly to Phoenix, AZ

We fly to sunny Arizona and overnight in Tempe. Radisson Hotel or Similar – After a Phoenix, AZ

DAY 2: Hermosillo, San Carlos

This morning we depart by deluxe motorcoach, crossing the border into Mexico at Nogales and arriving at Santa Ana for lunch. After lunch we depart for Hermosillo where we visit the Cathedral and the Government Palace to view the famous murals depicting the history of Sonora. DAY 3: Cruise on Sea of Cortez, Cactus Garden

After a relaxed breakfast we board a private boat for a scenic cruise on the Sea of Cortez as we watch for dolphins, seals, exotic birds and possibly whales. Once again on land, we visit a scenic overlook enroute to the local Cactus Garden. Wander among massive cacti and learn about these fascinating plants. We enjoy lunch at the hotel. DAY 4: Guaymas Pearl Farm, Alamos, Folkloric Show

Farm, the first cultured pearl farm in North America. We learn about pearl oyster farming, pearl grading and quality selection. We then travel south through the rich grain farm lands and to the foothills of the Sierra Madre Mountains, arriving in the quaint city of Alamos. This town is a living museum. The cobblestone streets are lined with beautiful Spanish Colonial Mansions. At dinner we immerse ourselves in the local culture as we enjoy a colorful spectacle of music and folk dancing by performers wearing traditional costumes. Casa de Los La Mansion or Casa Tesorbs. DAY 5: Touring Alamos, El Fuerte After breakfast we enjoy a guided walking tour through the cobblestone streets of Alamos. Barrancas, Tarahumara Indian Culture Casas Grandes, Mexico (B, L, D) Presentation

Early this morning we transfer to the

train station and board at 8:00am. This train is known as the most spectacular train ride in North America. We enjoy lunch onboard and we arrive at Posada Barrancas by mid-afternoon. Our hotel for the next two nights is the Hotel Mirador. We enjoy a Tarahumara Indian Culture presentation tonight. Hotel Mirador — Posada Barrancas, Mexico (B, L, D)

DAY 7: Posada Barrancas

Today, we can explore the Tarahumara Indian Arts and Crafts, visit the rim of canyon and enjoy surroundings. We have an opportunity to board the Copper Canyon Aerial tramway that descends into the Canyon with great views. There is time today for some optional activities: horseback riding or just hiking, Hotel Mirador — Posada relaxing. Barrancas, Mexico (B, L, D)

DAY 8: Nuevo Casas Grandes, Mata Oritz Pottery Demonstration

After breakfast, we transfer to Creel by way of Oteros Canyon. After lunch in Guerrero, we descend from the mountains into the Chihuahuan Desert and the city of Nuevo Casas Grandes. DAY 9: Casas Grandes, Paquime

Before leaving Nuevo Casas Grandes, visit Mexico's northernmost archeological site at Paquime where the ancient Grand Chichimeca civilization erected their pyramids and adobe multistory apartments. travel through the plains and cattle country of Chihuahua before reentering the USA at Douglas, AZ. Arrive in Phoenix early this evening. Radisson Hotel or Similar -Phoenix, AZ (B, L)

DAY 10: Departure

We depart this morning on our return flight home. (DCB)
